Dear CCHS Parents, Students, Faculty and Staff,

Charlotte Catholic High School continues to actively monitor information available about the Coronavirus (COVID-19). We are following the CDC guidelines regarding this situation, and we ask you to please understand that it is changing constantly.

If any student or faculty member has a fever, cough or cold symptoms, he or she should not attend school. No one with any symptoms should attend any school-related events.

We understand many of the college students are home for extended periods, and we always enjoy seeing our young alumni. However, we cannot allow them to visit at this time. Beginning immediately, in an effort to limit any community spread, only current CCHS parents and persons who have official school business may visit the campus. All visitors should continue to check in at the main entrance security vestibule.

Please be aware of the following scheduled events and any current adjustments. We will notify you again should there be any additional postponements or cancellations.

1. The SAT will be conducted this Saturday, March 14 as scheduled. Please see today's Daily Announcements for additional details.
2. The Choral Concert scheduled for March 16 has been canceled.
3. Cougar Caritas has been canceled.
4. As mentioned in a letter yesterday, Superintendent Debbie Mixer has given CCHS permission for students to remain at home and practice online classes next Tuesday, March 17. Faculty and staff will report for a regular day and we will work out any kinks so that we are prepared should the need arise for online instruction. Students, faculty and staff will resume the regular school schedule on Wednesday, March 18.
5. The Kairos retreat March 20-22 has been canceled.
6. The CCHS Band Concert is on as scheduled for March 22 for immediate family only. Mr. Cook will send details.
7. The spring play "Fiddler on the Roof" is March 25-28 with limited seating and priority to immediate family.
8. The Community Fish Fry scheduled for March 27 has been canceled.
9. The STEM Career Day March 30 has been postponed. A new date is TBD.
10. The NCHSAA has suspended all high school athletics statewide effective tonight at midnight until April 6. This includes all games, team workouts and practices.
11. At this time, prom is on as scheduled for April 25.
