

PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN PERMISSION SLIP

1. Students must enter the gym with the adult who transported them. Students will be released to parent's custody promptly at 9pm.
2. St. Rose of Lima School administration officials, faculty, and their designates will be the sole chaperones at all middle school dances/mixers at St. Rose of Lima School.
3. At the discretion of the principal and pastor, a City of Warwick Police Officer may be hired to police a dance/mixer at St. Rose of Lima School.
4. All students and visiting students must be dressed appropriately and modestly. No tank tops, tube tops, see through tops, shirts showing midriff, spaghetti straps, halter tops, miniskirts, short shorts, low-fitting pants, pajama/lounge pants, baseball caps, heels larger than 2 inches, ripped jeans, or clothing too tight or with any messages, logos, pictures or slogans that conflict with Catholic values. The chaperones have the right to determine acceptable attire, and their decisions will be final.
5. Inappropriate, suggestive or aggressive dancing is not permitted at any time.
6. ***A cell phone or other electronic device may be brought to a St. Rose School dance/mixer for use to call a parent/guardian at the end of the night or in case of any emergency. Cell phones and other electronic devices may NOT be used for any other purpose. Cell phones and other electronic devices will be confiscated and returned at the end of the dance/mixer if used contrary to this policy.
7. Backpacks and sports bags are not allowed at a St. Rose of Lima School dance/mixer.
8. All students attending a dance/mixer at St. Rose of Lima School must remain the entire time unless sickness ensues or another arrangement has been made before the dance/mixer with student's parent/guardian and the principal.
9. Only students from schools that participate in a St. Rose of Lima School dance/mixer are permitted to attend the dance/mixer. All other students, friends and family are prohibited from attending the dance/mixer.
10. All students and visiting students will abide by the rules of St. Rose of Lima School. Failure to comply with school rules will result in dismissal from the dance/mixer and may result in further disciplinary action.
